On **Thursday, March 6, 2025, at 1:30 p.m.**, the Kent County Planning Commission will review a site plan application submitted by KNR, Inc., requesting final review of a proposal to construct a new convenience store and deli. The property is located at 10816 Worton Road in the Third Election District and is zoned Village (V).

The *Kent County Land Use Ordinance* requires the Planning Commission to review proposals to assure good arrangement and appearance, consistency with the County's Comprehensive Plan, and compliance with all County regulations.
