On **Thursday, March 6, 2024, at 1:30 p.m.**, the Kent County Planning Commission will review the site plan application submitted by Sassafras Veterinary Services, LLC, for concept site plan review to renovate and construct a two-story addition to their existing animal hospital facility. The property is located at 10530 Augustine Herman Highway in the Second Election District and is zoned Crossroads Commercial (CC).

The *Kent County Land Use Ordinance* requires the Planning Commission to review proposals to assure good arrangement and appearance, consistency with the County's Comprehensive Plan, and compliance with all County regulations.
